

## FINAL REVIEW

### ALBERTO HEVIA WINS THE RALLY PRÍNCIPE

Alberto Hevia was proclaimed this afternoon as the winner of the 47 Rally Príncipe de Asturias, a round of the FIA European Rally Championship.

The Italian Conrado Fontana began very competitively and was one of the pre-rally favourites but he had bad luck and left the road on the second stage of the rally, which left Hevia as the leader, a position he was to maintain until the end of the event by continually setting the fastest stage times.

Victor Senra was classified second with an advantage that he steadily increased over his pursuers and the third position in the FIA European Rally Championship was comfortably taken by Miguel Fuster.

This podium coincided with that of the Spanish Championship as Pedro Burgo, who had been occupying third position, was unlucky enough to be forced to retire due to mechanical failure on the final stage.

Gorka Antxustegui, Luigi Fontana and Antonin Tlustak were next in the overall classification.

In the Trophy events victory in the Suzuki Trophy went to Ferrán Pujol and in the Mitsubishi Trophy the winner was Fran Cima.

In the Trofeo Deporte Asturiano the top spots went to Faustino Ontiveros in Group B, Jose Manuel Alonso in Group C, Julio Cesar Méndez in Group D and Felix Alvarez in Group E.

The organisation would like to make known their appreciation for the collaboration at all times by the different participating forces of public order in the Rally, because they have enormously helped the work of organisation and thanks are also due to each and every one of the different people who from one or other aspect of the organisation who have collaborated in its success.
