BERTI HEVIA ON THE VERGE OF TAKING THE RALLY

Alberto Hevia is on course to become the winner of the 47 edition of the Rally Príncipe de Asturias when he set yet another fastest stage time and to increase his lead by further 19 seconds from his main rival Victor Senra who is satisfied with the second position that he has secured barring for mechanical failure.

When finishing the stage, Alberto Hevia commented that he is hearing noises from all over, but he continues leading the rally without problem and without opposition after the retirement yesterday of his main rival Conrado Fontana.

Alberto Hevia who was a little slower than on his first run on the spectacular stage of Morcín and was almost beaten by Miguel Fuster but held on by just one second. A good result too for Xavier Lujua who was two seconds away from the fastest time but unfortunately Sergio Lopez Fombona was forced to retire due to mechanical failure.

In the Trofeo Deporte Asturiano Felix Alvarez consolidated his lead to increase the gap to more than a minute ahead of Jose Manuel Alonso.
